

## 20<sup>th</sup> Century/Washington State History - Grading Policy

Student assessment will be passed on tests, projects, and quizzes weighted at 75% of the term grade and daily work worth 25% of the grade.

93-100% = A	Performance that exceeds the standard
90-92.99% = A-	
87-89.99% = B+	Performance that meets the standard
83-86.99% = B	
80-82.99% = B-	
77-79.99% = C+	Performance that is below standard
73-76.99% = C	
70-72.99% = C-	
55-69.99% = F	Performance that is well below standard, but the student showed an effort to attempt to get to standard. <b>(Grade can be raised to a D, see below)</b>
0=54.99 = F	Performance that is well below standard without the required effort to attempt to get to standard.

### Quiz/Test Retakes:

- All students, regardless of grade earned on an original quiz/test, will have a chance to retake all quizzes and tests, **except final quarter tests**.
- Class research projects and the CBA which is required by the state of Washington will also be a weighted as a test but **cannot** be retaken.
- If a student attempts a retake of a quiz/test, the maximum score will be 93%.
- If a student attempts a second retake of a quiz/test, the maximum score will be 87%.
- If a student attempts three or more retakes of a quiz/test, the maximum score will be 80%.

### "D" grades:

A student who at the end of the quarter has a final grade of F, but an overall percentage above 55%, will have his/her grade raised to a D provided both of the following have occurred:

- The student did a retake on all quizzes and tests on which he/she scored lower than 80%.
- The student improved his/her score from the original quiz/test on each retake that was attempted.

The student who receives a D is still performing well below standard, but is putting forth the effort to improve.

**\*For Washington State History in the second semester, students will receive quarter grades measuring progress for each quarter and a semester grade which is based on the cumulative average over the two quarters.**

- **This policy will serve as your child's first graded History assignment. It will count as 3 points of daily work. It needs to be signed and returned by Wednesday, August 31, 2011. If it is returned Thursday or Friday, it will earn only two points and one point if turned in next week.**
